Nomination Guidelines:

1. Must be a current and active member of the Oklahoma Chapter of the IAAI (attend seminars, share skills and experiences)
2. Must be someone who has shown outstanding achievement, through the use of professional expertise, in both the criminal and civil fields of arson control.
3. Must have had a successful completion of a recognized and tested course in fire investigation related work. (Examples: any state certification course by OSU, OU, OSU Tech, TU, or any other college / university, the National Fire Academy, or an IAAI or OKIAAI tested course.

If nominee has a tested course not mentioned, please indicate in the space provided on the form.
Membership in the IAAI is not required, but strongly encouraged.

The Investigator of the Year Award nomination form must be filled out completely or the nomination will not be accepted.
